Theme: Time

I. Opening prayer

Allow me not to miss you because of the hurry of busyness, but let me sense the fullness of your presence in each moment. Slow down both my feet and my heart that I might be more present to you as I go about my normal activities. In the Name of Jesus I pray, Amen.

2 Corinthians 5:11-6:2

Mark 13: 32-37

Hebrews 3: 7-19

IV. Readings for Reflection

In each moment of chronological time, the divine value of each moment is available to us in proportion to our sensitivity to the Spirit of Christ.
